- As of March 31, 2022, Fresno Pacific University had disbursed \$5,827,176 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants (HEERF III) to students.
- Fresno Pacific University estimates the number of students in Fall 2021 eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to be 3,600.
- Fresno Pacific University estimates the number of students in Spring 2022 eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to be 3,100.
- 5,782 students have been awarded Emergency Financial Aid Grants in amounts ranging from \$75 to \$2,180 as of March, 31, 2022. (Duplicated Headcount)
- Method of Awarding of Emergency Financial Aid Grants:

Ken Isaak – Additional Emergency Student Assistance Grants

Students who submit a Ken Isaak Request form are evaluated based upon whether their circumstances describe items in the Cost of Attendance or costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic. If the Ken Isaak Request is approved, an Emergency Student Assistance Grant of up to \$1,000 is awarded to the student. The university is currently limiting students to one additional grant.

Edquity Emergency Assistance Grants

Students who submit an Emergency Assistance Grant through the Edquity platform are evaluated using a research-based scoring algorithm to determine level of need for items in the Cost of Attendance or costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic. If the Emergency Assistance Grant is approved, an Emergency Student Assistance Grant of \$500 or \$1,000 is awarded to the student. The university is currently limiting students to one additional grant per semester.

<u>ARPA Grant – Student Assistant Grants</u> Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in a degree or credential program for 1 or more units in Fall 2021.
- Funds are meant to cover components of the Cost of Attendance (Tuition + Fees, Books, Living Expenses, Food, Transportation, etc.), or expenses related or incurred due to COVID-19.

Awarding Priority

- Awarding is based upon the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and the number of units in which they are enrolled as of October 1, 2021. Students who do not have an EFC on file are awarded a base amount depending upon the units in which they are enrolled.
- Award amounts increase as the EFC decreases and the number of units increase thus awarding higher grant amounts to students with higher financial need and cost of tuition. Additionally, higher overall awards are given to undergraduate and credential students versus graduate students as grad students are ineligible for Pell funds. According about 80% of the funds expended are designated to students who have an EFC in the Pell-eligible range.

Award Amounts

• Award amounts for Fall 2021 varied between \$140 and \$2,180 per student.

Awarding Process

ARPA Grant

The ARPA Grant is available to all degree and credential students, regardless of citizenship or status, who are enrolled in at least one unit of credit in Fall 2021 and/or Spring 2022.

Funds are awarded based upon degree level, enrollment and EFC range with larger awards given to full-time undergraduate and credential students with high financial need. Funds are disbursed according to the following matrixes.



Good news! Fresno Pacific University is officially kicking off a partnership with the Edquity app to help bring emergency grants and resources to students experiencing a financial crisis.

Undergraduate students currently enrolled part-time (6 credits) and full-time (12 credits) or Graduate students currently enrolled part-time (5 credits) and full-time (9 units) are now eligible to

apply for Emergency Assistance Grants (EAG), which are additional financial support funds provided by Fresno Pacific University to assist students with emergency aid during 2021-2022 academic year. To apply, all you need to do is complete the easy steps listed below. The Emergency Assistance Grant can help you with childcare, food, housing, learning materials, transportation, and other health/safety needs. During the application process, you will be asked to note which of these areas you need help with. You are encouraged to select all categories where you need assistance, as an EAG can help with more than one category of need if awarded.

Go to the App Store or Google Play Store and download the Edquity App or apply online at http://app.edquity.co.

After you complete an application, Edquity will provide you with an application decision within 24 hours.

If you have been approved for funding, you can claim your funds by logging back into your Edquity account and selecting a payment method.
